FAMILY VACATION





The creator of South Bohemia must have been trying to fulfil so many different kinds of wishes that he created a landscape that could satisfy any desire that anyone could want. The area is so full of opportunities for family vacations during which you can enjoy sports, culture, nature, fun, or adrenalin sports that you could even fit it all into one day. Those who run accommodation, food facilities and programs are becoming more and more used to working with families with children – at Lake Lipno, for example, there are several new children's playgrounds and a rich offer of animation programs for kids. It certainly pays off to include young people in the offer, because once they've experienced South Bohemia, they're sure to want to come back.

REGION OF ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE

České Budějovice – a city of experiences

Bring your family to České Budějovice and spend a vacation or weekend here – the metropolis of South Bohemia has something to offer to everyone. Check into a hotel of your liking, or perhaps a B&B or campground, and set off for a day of fun and adventures. Children with agile hands will enjoy a visit to a ceramic workshop or a glass-blowing factory, where they can create their own ceramic artwork or glass object. The more athletic can rent skyrunner shoes and jump around the town like Puss in Boots, or try their skill at an artificial rock wall. For those prefer golf, there is a course nearby where you can introduce your children to the sport, or get a game in yourself. And everyone is sure to enjoy the Hluboká Zoo, where you'll have the entire world of animals presented to you, not to mention their various offer of games and contests. Good weather might send you swimming in the nearby Bezdrev Pond. After returning to České Budějovice you can attend a cultural event in the evening, and finally choose a pleasant restaurant to finish the day off with good food.

Come and play – fun and education in the region of Týn nad Vltavou

In the Municipal Museum of Týn nad Vltavou, visitors can explore the exhibition of regional history and log-rafting, puppets, the memorial hall of Alfréd Radok and the collection of vitavin (moldavite) stones. Beneath the museum there are underground passages, now open. The exhibition of puppets is prepared for children and they can even play their own marionette theatre. The station called Help Nature at Semec near Týn nad Vltavou is a place of relaxation near the confluence of the Vltava and Lužnice Rivers. Hikers can become acquainted with the geological and paleontological exhibition, the collection of pine trees from around the world, medicinal plants and the exhibition of forestry societies in South Bohemia. Children can try the Sensation Trail and play a village version of „Sorry!“. The Vysoký Hrádek Castle contains an information center for JE Temelín with an exhibition of nuclear energy. Visitors can test their knowledge during an entertaining quiz and take a virtual tour of an electric power plant. You can also relax at the castle's park with its collection of rare trees and system of ponds. The Museum of Historical Vehicles in Pořežany contains an extensive collection of all types of vehicles, models of historic automobiles, trains and airplanes, agricultural technology and many other items.



REGION OF ČESKÝ KRUMLOV

Český Krumlov for families

Every family can choose something different from the wide and extensive offer of Český Krumlov. Right in the center of the town you can visit the Fairy Tale House which contains a number of famous and well-known Czech and international marionettes. There is also a mechanical model of St. Stephen's Fair which will be of interest to children and adults alike. There are also marionettes on display in the Marionette Museum. Go the Torture Museum for a bit of dark fun and enlightenment, and the Wax Museum will supplement a tour of the town. If you feel like taking your kids up to the castle, don't forget to say hello to the Krumlov bears in the castle moat. A visit to the Graphite Mines is an unforgettable experience, taking you down into the mine in a mining train.

REGION OF DAČICE - SLAVONICE

The town of Slavonice

Slavonice is located on the border area of the three historical territories of Bohemia, Moravia and Austria on the eastern periphery of Czech Canada. More than 30 homes in the center of town are decorated with sgraffito, and as far as the number and level of their content difficulty is concerned, there is no equal in the Czech Republic. The cellar vaults are also of global significance. You can visit the Municipal Museum, the Town Tower, and the Lutheran Prayer Room. Close by you can visit the fortress area or archaeological site of Pfaffenschlag. The magnificent surrounding nature is suitable for year-round sports recreation. Children will enjoy a trip to the nearby village of Maříž, where they can create their own ceramic cup – slightly older children, from about four or five years old, can enlist the help of their parents or a teacher to paint their own cup with a special technique, which will then be fired for them in the kiln and sent by mail.

Dačice – the town that gave the world sugar cubes

Do you sweeten your beloved coffee or tea with a cube of sugar? And did you know that it originated in Dačice? A reminder of this sweet discovery, a granite memorial to the sugar cube, has been on the Dačice town square since 1983. The first sugar refinery in Moravia was founded here in 1833 on the site of the Old Town Hall and today's house No. 4 on Palacký Square. Dačice is a natural center of the region not only due to its position but also because of the number of services available here. The surrounding forests, historic monuments, and memorial places, often surrounded by legends, create a picturesque character of the town and surrounding countryside.



REGION OF JINDŘICHŮV HRADEC

Vacation in Jindřichův Hradec

Jindřichův Hradec – the pearl of South Bohemia – has something to offer visitors any time of the year. The majority of visitors, however, naturally come to the city above the Vajgar Pond in the summer months. This is when all the most significant monuments are open, as is the aquapark with its several water attractions and narrow-gauge trains pulled by a steam locomotive set off on romantic rides through Czech Canada. July in Jindřichův Hradec brings the renowned music festival Folk Rose as well as the dramatic theatre presentations on the 3rd castle courtyard. In August the castle complex echoes with operatic arias and the town park is where the smaller ones say goodbye to summer vacation in the popular event „The Town for Children“. During the summer vacation months, there are attractive and popular night tours of the State Castle and Chateau. Consider all this, and we can safely say that any vacation week of the summer is a good time to visit Jindřichův Hradec.



REGION OF LIPNO

Adventure for the entire family at the „Sea of South Bohemia“

The Lake Lipno area is full of quiet places, ways to relax, long-lasting peace with your family, while at the same time it hides enough opportunities to enjoy an active vacation with everything available during any kind of weather. Thanks to the unique combination of the vast water surface and the magnificent Šumava landscape with its hundreds of kilometres of bike, hiking, and in-line skating trails, you can enjoy plenty of fun with your entire family during vacation. Try out a Lipno speciality – a ride on the electric boat Darato, ride the downhill run in the Specialized Bikepark Lipno, or take the rope climb challenge in the Rope Park. All this can be safely managed by every member of the family. The less adventurous will surely enjoy the chair lift up to the top of Kramolín, the view onto the lake, or a stroll along any of the hiking trails around Lipno.



REGION OF PÍSEK

In the steps of the Homolka family

A one-day trip for the entire family offers you the chance to discover the magic of the Písek Mountains as well as explore the area where the Czech cult comedy „Hogo Fogo Homolka“ was filmed. The walk begins above Písek in the area known as „U Vodáka“, renowned for its system of ponds and moulon preserves, which are better seen from an animal observation stand. The hiking trail leads you uphill to the lookout spot of the Písek forest wardens, then onwards to the Jarník lookout tower. From here it's only a small ways to the Živec chalet. The veranda of this hiking chalet will remind Czech film fans of the part of the film in which Grandpa Homolka drank his moonshine and was gearing up for treatment. Following refreshments, you can set off for another film location, the terrier training ground, which is found only a short ways (150m) from Živec. The more romantic types can enjoy the Písek Mountains' dreamy hideaway known as Lom U Obrázku.

Čížová and surroundings

Čížová lies about 6km far from Písek. Its monuments and tourist attractions include the church of St. Jacob from the 13th century standing on a hill of the same name, the chapel of St. Barbara, a belltower, and an altan well. Čížová and its immediate surroundings boast typical village architecture as well as modern styles. The town is on the crossroads of several bike and hiking routes including several international routes. You'll surely appreciate the natural sites of interest such as the protected territories of Hrba, Certová Hora, Dubná and Zlíbky u Vráže. Be sure to visit the animal rescue station Makov in Nová Ves and the horse training facility in Bošovice. Čížová offers many facilities for overnight sleeping and eating. We look forward to your visit and wish you a pleasant stay.

REGION OF PRACHATICE

The celebrations of the Salt Golden Route

Come with us to renew tradition and transport yourself back to Prachatice in the previous century. Imagine that some kind of horse caravan is approaching town, bringing a load of salt with it. This is how our two-day program begins, with caravans, clowns, jugglers, jesters, artisans and musicians, historical parades accompanied by drums and flags, an old Bohemian street market with craft demonstrations, jousting tournaments, street and stage music and theatre shows and a night tour with torches. The festival takes place on the last weekend of June every year in the historic center of the town of Prachatice. During the event you can also visit the family museum of Czech Marionettes and Circus, the Prachatice Museum, the St. Jacob Church tower and galleries in the center of town. The sports facilities in Prachatice offer plenty to do for the athletes in your family, including the Hulák swimming pool, the indoor swimming pool with steam room, in-line track, skatepark, a tennis court and a soccer field. For relaxation, visit the sauna „U Jablečňáka“, the salt cave „Thalasa“, or the sports and relaxation center Albatros.



REGION OF TÁBOR

A week in the region of Tábor

The historic city of Tábor and its surroundings have always enjoyed a rich past and number of architectural monuments, a rich cultural offer, plenty of sports opportunities and quiet places for relaxing, all making this an attractive place for visitors. Tábor has undergone many changes over the centuries, but has still managed to retain its Medieval character even today. The gently rolling landscape around Tábor is an ideal location to spend a pleasant holiday. You can explore an entire array of popular monuments – castles, mansions, natural places of interest, and technical monuments. The wetland landscape here is also unique, spreading out along the southern part of the region with its typical South Bohemian architecture, lakes and vast woodlands. The nature around Tábor boasts ideal conditions for hiking, biking and horse riding. The Lužnice River, connecting the entire region, is ideal for canoeing, fishing, and swimming. The town of Veselí nad Lužnicí

Veselí nad Lužnicí is located in the Třeboň lowlands on the confluence of the rivers Lužnice and Nežárka, at an altitude of 410 meters. Even though Veselí used to belong to the vast Rožmberk dominion which made it a place of frequent festivals and wassails (hence the name Veselí - merrymaking), only a few significant historic monuments have been preserved in the town including the Renaissance Old Town Hall, the Blatské Museum, the Weis House and the church of the Erection of the Holy Cross. This makes the location of the town that much more significant – it is surrounded by forests, sandpits and countless small and large ponds, making it attractive for several day trips on foot, bicycle or by public transportation. Here you can visit the castle of Červená Lhota, Hluboká nad Vltavou, Třeboň, Jindřichův Hradec and Český Krumlov. Veselí offers a wide range of accommodation facilities from campgrounds, private accommodations, B&B's and a three-star hotel. There is also a rich cultural and sports program available.

REGION OF TŘEBOŇ

A vacation in Třeboň

Třeboň is a pearl of the Renaissance – the castle and town in the charming landscape of the Třeboň lowlands, and a landscape of forests, fields and ponds. There are endless events going on in the summer season in Třeboň, either on the main Masarykovo Square, or in the adjacent castle courtyards or park. The season begins in May with the international animated film festival AniFest. In June there is a traditional festival of rock and folk music known as Okolo Třeboně, June sees the Třeboň Nocturna honouring Emma Destinn, then the historic Třeboň festival celebrating Jakub Krčín, then the festival Lázeňská Třeboň in August presenting the spas Aurora and Bertiny, then Rybářská Třeboň to celebrate fishermen and their patron, St. Peter. For those who don't care for cultural events, there is the historical town center with its rampart walls, towers, Augustinian monastery, castle with defense walls and interesting park, then along the bulkhead of the Svět Pond and all the way perhaps to the Schwarzenberg family tomb.



REGION OF VIMPERK

Vimperk – families with children welcome

If you're planning to visit Vimperk with the entire family, we've got several trip tips prepared for you. First, we recommend a trip to the information center on the main square in Vimperk to load up on necessary materials. In addition to the abundance of information you'll find here, we also have a fully accessible internet corner with 3 computers, a children's corner with plenty of toys, and even a changing table. There is also a public WC available. A DVD shows regional information about Vimperk including the Šumava National Park and Protected Landscape Preserve. We can also arrange a visit to the Minimuseum of the Gold Route and municipal belltower in Vimperk. Children are sure to love the Minizoo of native Czech animal species as well as the horse-riding school at the Skalce Castle in Bohumilice, 7km far from Vimperk. The Minizoo is near the B&B Sumavous in the former military barracks U Sloupů. If you're into adrenalin sports, visit the Rope Park at Churáňov, paintball at the former barracks U Sloupů (1 km far from Vimperk), or the mountain scooters at Kubova Huť. For water lovers, we recommend the public swimming facility in Vimperk or the swimming pool Rohanov near Vacov.
